The Sherman County Preschool is now a community supported preschool and will NO longer be contracted or affiliated with North Central ESD and the Head Start Program. We will however be working to be able to provide scholarships for those who typically would rely on a Head Start spot.

The preschool will be offering scholarships again this year. There will be a google form for parents to apply. To qualify for the scholarship, you must complete and submit an application for Free and Reduced Meals through the state of Oregon. This application can be found on Sherman County School District's website as well as online through Oregon Department of Education.

Please note that tuition is due by the 15th of each month. A late fee of \$5.00 will be applied after the 15th, if prior arrangements have not been made. If your account becomes consistently delinquent your child may no longer attend preschool until the account is brought current. Tuition for September will be due August 15th to ensure your spot is held for you. Brightwheel is the payment application the Preschool used to make payments. You are welcome to pay by debit ach, or credit card through our Brightwheel App. Please note there is a fee if paying by credit card. All invoices and receipts will be sent through email from Brightwheel.

Children must be 3 to 5 years old on or before Sept. 1 to enroll in the preschool.

Children in the A.M. Session will be offered breakfast and lunch. Children in the P.M. Session will be offered lunch. We encourage families to complete a Free/Reduced Rate application through the school district as we receive meals through the school district.

We will begin the year with a staggered start. Half of the class will come on the 1st day of school the other half will come on the 2nd day then everyone attends thereafter. The school calendar will be sent out with family acceptance packets following acceptance.

For parent convenience Sherman County Preschool Board of Directors has a bus agreement with North Wasco School District to offer a bus route with stops outside of each daycare in Moro and Wasco **ONLY.** Our bus route for the afternoon session will be picked up from Wasco and Moro daycares and then dropped off at the preschool. Students from the morning session will then load the bus and be taken to Moro and Wasco daycares.

Transportation is a significant expense and may change based on the number of children using the bus and the cost of the contract. New this year to help cover transportation costs we will be implementing a \$25.00 per month for students who will be on the bus.

Parents will be invited to join the app "ClassDojo". This is a great tool we use to communicate with parents and post notices.

Enrollment forms are due by June 21st can either be dropped off at the preschool with Ashley, Jessie, or Tionie. Or can be mailed to our PO Box 66 Moro, 97039

Our morning session will be capped at 15 students this year, to make sure we equally split classes. We will review after enrollment is complete.

Please know Sherman County Preschool is NOT a part of the school district so please do not call the school district with preschool questions. Please contact the teachers or the board directly with any questions you may have using the phone number or email address listed above.

SHERMAN COUNTY PRESCHOOL OUR PHILOSOPHY OF LEARNING

In a caring and positive atmosphere, we create a warm and happy place for preschoolers to learn. As we bridge the gap from home to school, we guide children to a continued good self-image while building both academic and social skills in an inviting classroom setting.

Sensory, motor, perceptual and language skills are introduced through materials and activities which are both child-centered and teacher-directed. Work is planned which emphasizes the process rather than the product, fostering a sense of accomplishment and pride.

Based on the theory that children learn through play, classroom routines encourage active involvement, meaningful experimentation and reinforcement through repetition. Schedules are designed which balance, structure and free choice, as well as active and quiet times.

Recognizing that children grow in somewhat predictable stages, we treat each child as an individual, working from the level each child has attained and moving forward a step at a time. We teach a love of learning by allowing children to experience their own state of development and helping them to feel success without pressure.

We value the active involvement of parents in our program, both through committee and classroom participation. Parent Helper days enable the children to see their parents as important and concerned members of the new school environment, while providing parents with opportunities to view the child with teachers and other children.

Parents may gain valuable insights and techniques from the expertise of the staff and, at the same time, share their own talent and interests to maintain the excellent quality here at Sherman County Preschool. School then becomes a shared experience which hopefully will continue throughout each child's educational process.
